



# Maine Audubon Winter Vacation Programs

## FEBRUARY 16 - BIRD HOMES

Tuesday's activity is building and installing bird nesting and roosting boxes. Spend the morning hammering the boxes together. In the afternoon we'll locate and install the boxes on the Audubon property.

## FEBRUARY 17 - INSECTS

Wednesday's activity is searching for winter insects. Strap on a pair of snowshoes and search the Audubon property for signs of insects surviving the cold Maine winter. Along the way we may discover signs of other creatures spending the winter in Maine.

## FEBRUARY 18 - ICE FISHING

Thursday's activity is ice fishing on Fields Pond. Drill holes in the ice by hand auger. Set tip-ups for catching fish and see what happens! Make snow sculptures and paintings while we wait for the fish to bite. All fish will be released.

## FEBRUARY 19 - MAPLE SYRUP

Friday is all about maple syrup. Campers experience the entire process; identifying a sugar maple; drilling a tap hole; collecting the sap; cooking the sap into syrup; and eating syrup on pancakes!
