



# Audubon Summer Day Programs

## One-day Adventure Camps

Fields, forest, streams and ponds- there's a lot to explore every day at Fields Pond Audubon Center! Join us for one or all of our one day nature explorations—we will explore, create, play, learn! Programs run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Enrollment is limited to ten children per session. Cost per program: \$40/ members, \$50/nonmembers.

*What should my child bring?* Campers should bring a lunch, two snacks, a full water bottle, sunscreen, and a desire to explore! Programs fill fast! ### Recycled by Nature, Recycled by YOU. Tuesday, June 29 (ages 5-7)

Explore the forest and meet nature's recyclers. Then create your own recycled art and musical instruments.

### Water Bugs! Tuesday, July 6 (ages 6-8)

Use big nets and little nets to catch water bugs, learn how to identify them and use microscopes for amazing close-ups.

### Wild Things! Tuesday, July 13 (ages 6-8)

Be the wild things- build a shelter, identify edible native plants and create your wild thing banner with natural materials.

### All About Frogs and Salamanders Thursday, July 15 (ages 7-9)

Find, identify and gently handle frogs and salamanders while observing, catching, examining and releasing them.

### Mammal Mania Friday, July 30 (ages 8-10)

Explore some of the adaptations fur-bearing animals use to stay cool in the summer.

### Fashion a Fish Friday, August 6 (ages 8-10)

What makes a bass a bass and not a salmon? Learn about fish adaptations and fashion your own fish.

### Fish Interactions Tuesday, August 10 (ages 11-14)

Use Fields Pond as your aquatic laboratory. Collect fish and discover interactions of the aquatic community. Campers are encouraged to bring their own fishing gear.



## Two-day Family Adventures

Family adventures are a great way for campers, ages 4-6, to get a taste for exploration and share it with their favorite grownup! Each two-day family adventure includes exploration, movement, crafts, songs and stories. Programs run from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. Enrollment is limited to ten families. Cost per program: \$35/members, \$42/nonmembers.

### Birds

#### June 21, 22

Learn to identify some of your backyard feathered friends. Search out birds in trees, on the lake, and in the meadows. Watch them fly, climb and swim. Play bird bingo!

### Plants

#### July 26, 27

Help create a native plants garden. Roam through fields and forest in search of plants to smell, touch, and taste. Discover the wonders of flowers all around you.

### Insects

#### August 23, 24

Come and be fascinated by six-legged creatures and all of the quirky things they can do. Spot bugs crawling under logs, swimming in the water or walking through the grass. We'll create our own insects too!

### Nature Connections! Summer Day Camp

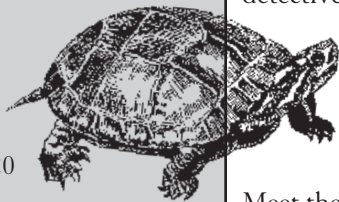
Camp meets weekdays from 9 am to 3 pm. Enrollment is limited to 18 children per session.

Explore, play, and learn through outdoor hands-on, minds-on games, craft and activities designed increase awareness of and connection to the natural community. Small camper groups let us build a community of cooperation and caring. Join Fields Pond Audubon Center naturalists and environmental educators for day camp explorations and adventures! Our summer day camp programs are for campers ages 6 to 12.

### Nature Detectives (ages 6 and 7)

Spy on a dragonfly, examine evidence of a mole! Be a nature detective and find the clues and signs left by animals who share your neighborhood. Use your senses and play games to discover the networks of your natural neighbors.

### Ecology Investigators (ages 8 and 9)

Follow the trail of water from babbling stream to pond. Meet the animals who live in our watershed- dragonflies, tadpoles, salamanders and fish. We'll play as loudly as a rushing river, observe as silently as a placid lake and have fun learning about our watery connections.

### Fields Pond Naturalists (ages 10-12)

Observe, investigate, create, share. What does it take to make an ecosystem work? You'll uncover secret connections in the world around us and we'll create skits and songs about our discoveries.

With a 192-acre wildlife sanctuary of forest, wetland and meadow, green-design nature center and the pond for which Fields Pond Audubon Center is named- there's discovery waiting every camper! All in Holden, just 10 minutes from Bangor.

Directions: From McDonald's on 1-A in Brewer, turn onto Green Point Road for one mile, then turn left on Wiswell Road. After 1.5 miles, turn right onto Fields Pond Road. The center is one mile farther, on the left.
