Maine Audubon Day Program DESCRIPTIONS

Water Bugs !

Learn what to look for. Then use a net to catch water bugs, learn how to identify them, and use microscopes to view them closely.

Frogs & Other Herps.

Learn how to find, identify and gently handle frogs, salamanders, turtles and snakes. Then search the property to locate, identify, examine and then release them.

Geocaching: Modern Treasure Hunting

This two day class is for older children seeking adventure. Geocaching combines geography and technology skills in a high tech outdoor treasure hunt that can be done worldwide. Children will learn the principles of navigation, explore computer websites and use a handheld GPS to locate hidden containers.

Fee: \$80/member; \$90/non-member

Deer Facts and Tracks

Spend the day learning how deer and other animals move, searching for their tracks and sign, looking at skulls and bones and collecting some tracks to take home. Along the way discover some interesting facts about our native animals.

Fish, Fish, & more Fish!

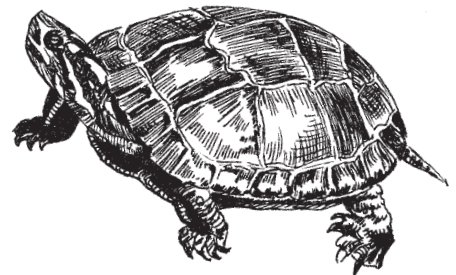
Experience the different ways fish biologists collect fish. Discover the fish living in Fields Pond by using minnow traps, trap nets, seine nets, and fishing rods. Life jackets needed for this activity, so bring your own and be prepared to get wet.

Canoeing Naturalist

Canoe Fields Pond and look for signs of fish, frogs, beaver, insects and osprey. Life jackets needed for this activity, so bring your own if you have one.

Capture Nature on Paper

Digital cameras are great for learning nature photography. Bring your own or use one of ours. Learn the basics for creating photos as you spend the morning on a photography hike. In the afternoon try your hand at drawing nature, while your photos are being printed.
